## **HAVE YOU HAD YOUR FENG SHUI TODAY?**

This year is The Year of the Water Dragon. The Dragon is the most auspicious symbol in Chinese culture and represents the strongest of energy, new beginnings and keeping of life. Dragons are symbols of imperial might and force and unlike the western concept where Dragons were considered monsters to be slain by knights and saints, the Chinese believe that those born in a Dragon year are powerful and wise.

Good Feng Shui does not bring you wealth if you do not strive for it or believe that you deserve it; It gives you the necessary support to seek what you desire. It helps you create an environment, both at home and at work, that will strengthen you and attract the energies to manifest your abundance and desires. First of all, be grateful for all that you have. Then implement these tips for support with your desires:

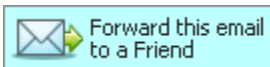
1. Make the first impression upon entering your home a warm and welcoming one.
2. Water is symbolic of money in Feng Shui, so ALWAYS keep the toilet lid down and the door to the bathroom(s) closed to prevent loss of money.
3. Outside waterfalls and fountains are especially helpful in creating more cash flow. They should be placed in the far left rear corner of your back yard and should flow toward the house. They can also be placed outside the front door, and must flow toward the front door. (Do not place a waterfall on the rear, right side of your back yard, as this could negatively impact your relationships.)

4. Make sure your address is clearly visible from the street both day and night so that Chi can find you.
5. Frogs and toads mean money. Place a toad or frog figurine or statue at your front door to invite money in. Their "moneybag" shape is very auspicious. Have the toad on the floor, **looking at the door** as it opens.
6. Make sure all the burners on the stove work, and use all of the burners (not just your favorite one). This is symbolic of your attracting money from many sources.
7. Remove plants from the center of the house. This area is ruled by the earth and you will lose income if there are plants here.
8. Get rid of any "dead" items in your home such as dried flowers. You want your wealth, as well as your health, relationships, career, etc., to thrive not be dead.
9. Paint your mailbox something fun, colorful and eye catching, especially if your business is home based. This will encourage more business through the mail.
